LEVERAGING RELATIONSHIPS

We recognize that for many students, learning is about relationships. You will be assigned a Learning Specialist with whom you will meet four times each week. Using a holistic, strengths-based approach and current research in brain-based learning, your Learning Specialist will partner with you to identify strategies for strengthening your academic skills and habits.

A wide range of services for international students offers ongoing support as you put skills to work in classes and participate in student life at Cushing.

The full menu of services offered through ESL is designed to help you advance as an international student in the United States: international student advisor, extra help sessions, and guidance in the college application process.

Advisors take pride in providing support and guidance in all areas of cultural adjustment as you get accustomed to the U.S. educational system and boarding school life.

You will find a wonderful sense of community at Cushing, where diversity and excellence are inseparable.

In addition to our ESL program, we offer TOEFL Review and an intensive summer program, which typically features eight levels of ESL instruction.

ARRANGE A CAMPUS VISIT AND INTERVIEW

On the day of the visit, prospective students and families will tour campus with a student tour guide, and separate interviews will take place for parents and the applicant. Families should plan to spend about two hours for the campus visit and interview.

The transcript should include all grades received over the past two years. Grades from the first semester of the current academic year must also be sent.

SUBMIT STANDARDIZED TESTING

All applicants must submit the appropriate standardized test scores.
