Cushing Academy, founded in 1865, is an independent, coeducational college preparatory boarding school located 60 miles northwest of Boston. Cushing Academy serves a wide range of students in grades 9-12 and offers a postgraduate year.

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RESPONSE TO COVID-19

For the school year 2020-2021 Cushing transitioned to a hybrid model of both in-person and remote classes. With a small number of exceptions*, students received traditional letter grades based on a full-year's completed work. Since the fall of 2021 students have been on campus for in-person learning.

*2020-2021: a 6-week Winterim term of entirely remote learning was added to the academic calendar. During Winterim students added a Pass/Fail course of their choosing, which is reflected on the transcript with P/F 0.25 credit. Additionally, a select few students were awarded Pass/Fail grades in core academic courses when individual circumstances surrounding Covid-19 and challenges with remote learning so warranted. Factors influencing these decisions will be addressed in counselor letters.



STANDARDIZED TESTING

In the current climate of test-optional admissions policies, Cushing supports student choice in whether or not to submit scores as part of their application. As such, we do not provide testing information as part of our profile.

GRADING SYSTEM

Cushing Academy uses a traditional 4.0 grading scale: A = 4.0, A = 3.7, B = 3.3, B = 3.0, etc. AP and Honors courses are weighted as follows: AP +0.5, Honors +0.3. A weighted GPA is provided on the transcript. D- is the lowest passing grade.

Cushing Academy uses a two-semester academic calendar. Full-year courses earn 1.0 credit; semester-long courses earn 0.5 credits.

Students who earn a GPA of 3.7 or higher for the term are placed on the High Honor Roll for the semester. Students earning a GPA between 3.3 and 3.69 are placed on the Honor Roll.

The Watkins Scholar Program annually awards full, need-based scholarships to a select few exceptional incoming 9th grade boarding students. Scholars possess both a love of learning and noteworthy academic achievement, strong leadership skills, outstanding character and a desire to contribute significantly to Cushing Academy. Watkins Scholars embody the highest academic and community ideals held by Cushing. They are annually among the school's most accomplished students and distinguished citizens.

ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

Thirty-four percent of the Cushing Academy student body hails from outside the United States. Roughly 6-8% of the student body participates in the English as a Second Language program. Courses are offered at the intermediate and advanced levels for school year 2023-2024.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Cushing Academy's Academic Support program offers a highly personalized academic atmosphere, designed to meet the needs of students with mild learning differences. Roughly 15-17% of the student body participates in this program.
